8:30am Band students go to Mr. Gossard's Room to tune (**please warm up at home**). After you tune, BB will place instruments on their chairs and AB will place instruments on the stage on the left side out of sight. Then you will go to the Media Center to watch a movie until the bell rings at 8:50am. Instruments will stay on stage. At 8:50am you will go to your homeroom and drop off your case and check in. You will stay with your HR when your classes come down to the cafeteria. Beginning Band will go immediately to the stage and Advanced Band will sit in special seats to the side of the stage. Students will then switch places so Advanced Band can perform.
